

The Cambridge Churches Homeless Project works with local churches and a local synagogue to provide a friendly welcome, hot supper, and safe space to sleep for up to 15 rough sleepers from December to March. 100s of volunteers support the project evening and overnight on a rota basis.

But we cannot ask volunteers to do everything – and this is where you come in! There is a lot of equipment and paperwork to be dealt with every day – collecting, delivering, cleaning, printing, purchasing, organising.

The Materials Coordinator will have the job of helping to close up the project each morning and ensure that everything is ready for the next evening.

Salary and travel expenses will be paid, 16 hours a week, Monday to Friday, December through March. You'll need access to a computer, internet, printer etc, and a suitable car. References will be needed, ideally including one from a local church minister.
